We are pleased to invite you to the Museum's 2017 International Council, which will take place from the morning of Sunday, June 4, through the evening of Wednesday, June 7. This year's Council, on the theme of Art and Artists in our Time, will focus on contemporary creative culture in Israel and worldwide, exploring how artists and their artistic enterprise add meaning to contemporary life.

The Council will also offer a great opportunity to meet our incoming Anne and Jerome Fisher Director, Eran Neuman, and other new members of the Museum's professional team. As always, we will enjoy tours of current exhibitions; behind-the-scenes workshops with curators, artists, and professional staff, highlighting important recent acquisitions; and gala evenings, including our traditional surprise venue closing dinner. And there will of course be ample time to connect with friends both old and new.

This year's program will also feature special activities for our growing circle of next-generation IMJI's, whom we should all encourage to be with us, helping to extend our Museum's unique history of first, second, and now third and fourth generation

We look forward to welcoming you to Jerusalem and to the Museum for what promises to be an exciting and enriching International Council and send all warmest regards for the New Year,
